The CoC PR-503, in its assembly for the NOFO 2023 competition, approved a Policy and Procedures Manual for the local competition that included all of the reallocation policies, including the minimum criteria established for a project to be evaluated for the competition, the quality threshold of 75% for all projects, the evaluation criteria and instruments for the projects of all of the housing components, and the criteria and processes for reduction of funding for recurring sub-utilization of grant funds. The CoC determined that the Jayuya PH project would be eliminated because it did not meet the 75% threshold for inclusion, obtaining a score of 71% on a CoC evaluation for the competition under which the findings included: poor compliance with HMIS data standards; tardiness in submission of HMIS data; limited participant in CoC assemblies and committee meetings; low bed-utilization rates during the year; unattended monitoring findings; excessive time between admission of participants and their placement in PH; low percent of participants increasing income from non-employment income (Measure 4); and sub-utilization of grant funds resulting in recaptured funds. The first notification of rejection was sent by the CoC to the municipal government of Jayuya on September 5, 2023, after which a meeting was held to discuss the reasons for the rejection, and a final notification was sent on September 12, 2023.

The CoC PR-503, in its assembly for the NOFO 2023 competition, approved a Policy and Procedures Manual for the local competition that included all of the reallocation policies, including the minimum criteria established for a project to be evaluated for the competition, the quality threshold of 75% for all projects, the evaluation criteria and instruments for the projects of all of the housing components, and the criteria and processes for reduction of funding for recurring sub-utilization of grant funds. The CoC determined that the Aguas Buenas PH project would be eliminated because it did not meet the 75% threshold for inclusion, obtaining a score of 60% on a CoC evaluation for the competition under which the findings included: poor compliance with HMIS data standards; tardiness in submission of HMIS data; lack of evidence of integration of persons with lived experience in planning and other activities; low bed-utilization rates during the year; excessive time between admission of participants and their placement in PH; low percent of participants increasing income from employment and non-employment income (Measure 4); and sub-utilization of grant funds resulting in recaptured funds. The first notification of rejection was sent by the CoC to the municipal government of Aguas Buenas on September 5, 2023, after which a meeting was held to discuss the reasons for the rejection, and a final notification was sent on September 12, 2023.

The CoC PR-503, in its assembly for the NOFO 2023 competition, approved a Policy and Procedures Manual for the local competition that included all of the reallocation policies, including the minimum criteria established for a project to be evaluated for the competition, the quality threshold of 75% for all projects, the evaluation criteria and instruments for the projects of all of the housing components, and the criteria and processes for reduction of funding for recurring sub-utilization of grant funds. The CoC determined that the Fortaleza del Caido DV Joint TH-RRH project would be eliminated because it did not pass the criteria to be evaluated established by the CoC PR-503. The organization did not have a completed Single Audit or an audited Financial Statement, nor had filed a tax form for non-profit organizations since 2018 with the Puerto Rico Treasury Department. Neither did they have a Good Standing certificate from the Puerto Rico State Department. The first notification of rejection was sent by the CoC to Fortaleza del Caido on September 5, 2023, after which a meeting was held to discuss the reasons for the rejection, and a final notification was sent on September 12, 2023.

The CoC PR-503, in its assembly for the NOFO 2023 competition, approved a Policy and Procedures Manual for the local competition that included all of the reallocation policies, including the minimum criteria established for a project to be evaluated for the competition, the quality threshold of 75% for all projects, the evaluation criteria and instruments for the projects of all of the housing components, and the criteria and processes for reduction of funding for recurring sub-utilization of grant funds. The CoC determined that the Municipality of Guayama PH project would have its funding reduced because it had an unexpended balance of over an average of 10% of its grant funds in the past three years. The municipality had an average of 18% of the assigned grant funds unexpended in the past three years. The first notification of rejection
